2020 PINOT “UNO”



Wine Summary:

In 2020, the coastal rains resulted in loss of the Pinot Noir grapes that make up our usual “Pinot+Pinot” blend....so the Pinot Gris got a chance to shine solo! Thus was born our Pinot “Uno”.

Tasting Notes:

The nose of this full-bodied white wine is loaded with savory yellow apple, nectarine, pear, dark tropical fruit (guava, perhaps?), and earthy floral aromas. Rich and round on the palette, the finish delights with hints of orange rind, kitchen spices, a touch of acidity, and slate.

Technical Data:

Varietal Composition: 92% Pinot Gris / 8% Aromella

Appellation: Massachusetts

Vineyard: Coastal Vineyard, South Dartmouth, MA

Aging Protocol: 100% Stainless steel for 24 months.

Alcohol by volume: 11% *Residual sugar:* <50 mg/L *Production Volume:* 800 bottles

Vintage and Production Notes:

Pinot Gris grapes from Coastal Vineyard, South Dartmouth, MA were hand-harvested and fermented in stainless steel using SVG yeasts, respectively. Following the primary fermentation, malolactic fermentation was prevented by the addition of SO₂ while aging over the fine lees in stainless steel for 24 months. The final wine was blended to taste with a small portion of Aromella was added to elevate the aromatics. Prior to bottling, the wine was filtered to 1.5 microns.
